Duke Ellington and his Harlem Cotton Club band, who closed at the Regal Thursday night, opened at E. and K.'s Uptown Friday, Feb. 27.

This will make the third week of the 18-week contract which Ellington holds with Publix houses. The Duke takes the same show he presented at the Oriental and Regal to his Uptown booking, including Ivy Anderson, Four Blazes and the Regalettes. The Four Blazes replaced Ford, Marshall and Jones, originally billed for the dancing skit in the show at the Oriental.

He will play the Paradise, Tivoli and Fisher, Detroit, before returning East for a call back to the Paramount, Brooklyn.
