

Bargain Offered Ellington's Fans

AMARILLO. July 4—Inaugurating an advance sale bargain, concert tickets purchased for the Duke Ellington orchestra concert before 6 p. m. Monday evening will be only 55 cents each. Wilbur C. Hawk, president of the Tri-State Fair Association, announced.

Ellington's orchestra will play for a concert in the Municipal auditorium from 8.15 until 10 o'clock Monday night. Following the concert there will be a dance at The Nat ballroom. It will be from 10:30 until 1:30 a. m.

To give out-of-town patrons full advantage of the bargain offer, all tickets that are prepaid before the 6 o'clock deadline Monday evening will be waiting the purchasers at the box office when the concert opens.

After the advance ticket sale ends at 6 o'clock Monday evening, the seats for the concert will be 85 cents each. The balcony has been set aside for negro patrons.

Admittance to the dance at The Nat will be \$1.65 per person, \$3.30 a couple, and \$2.50 for stags. Night club reservations may be made with the management of The Nat for 50 cents per person.
