INDIANA—All-time great musician Duke Ellington, and his world famous orchestra will appear in concert at Indiana University of Pennsylvania Wednesday, as the next attraction in this year's Artists Series. Performances are scheduled for Fisher Auditorium at 9 p.m. and 8:15 p.m. Tickets for found holders become available Nov. 27. The public can purchase tickets at the Student Union or at the box office Dec. 5 if any tickets remain at that time.

Indiana students, faculty and residents who can get tickets will hear a musical organization which in a typical month can span the spectrum of sacred concerts in churches and synagogues, performances with major symphony orchestras, college dances and symposia, nightclubs, dance halls, television specials and Las Vegas hotels. Bidding Quiz

You are South in each of the following three hands. What would you bid at the point where the question mark appears?

1. ♠ QJ74 ♠ AKJ5 ♠ AKJ2

South	West	North	East
1 ♠	Pass	1 ♥	1 ♠

2. ♠ AQJ4 ♥ 62 ♠ Q3 ♠ AQ72

North	East	South	West
1 ♠	Pass	2 ♠	Pass
3 ♥	Pass	?	?

3. ♠ Q85 ♥ AJ87 ♠ A64 ♠ Q96

North	East	South	West
1 ♠	Pass	1 ♥	Pass
3 NT	Pass	?	?

1. Two spades. You should enthusiastically take advantage of the spade suit and take advantage of it by bidding the suit. This tells partner that a game is certain, probably in hearts, and that a slam is only inches away. North may have any one of the following hands for his best bid:

♠ J52 ♥ K10 852 ♠ Q7 ♠ Q94
♠ 9742 ♠ A98653 ♠ 8 ♠ Q3
♠ 663 ♥ AK852 ♠ 9 ♠ 753

and with the first two a small slam is virtually certain, while with the last one a grand slam is a good shot.

2. Four hearts. Under the circumstances, it is perfectly proper to raise North to game in hearts with only two baby trumps. It is surely reasonable to assume that partner has at least six hearts when he bids three hearts, and hearts are therefore playable even opposite a doubleton.

You have a sound opening bid facing partner's opening bid, which means there's a game somewhere. With North unable to support clubs or spades, and apparently unwilling to play notrump, there is no real choice but to undertake the game in hearts. Partner may have any one of these hands:

♠ K73 ♥ AQJ883 ♠ J8 ♠ 86
♠ 883 ♥ KQJ7543 ♠ A9 ♠ 10
♠ K5 ♥ AK8754 ♠ K7 ♠ 63

and with each of them you'd be in four hearts.

3. Six notrump. This is one of those occasions when reaching the best contract is simply a matter of arithmetic. North's rebid of three notrump indicates at least 20 points and a balanced hand. Adding your 15 points to partner's, you have the 35 in the mandatory.
